



Twelve Disruptions to achieve SDGs

1	Disrupt Poverty and low productivity – people earn their human rights with increased productivity. Engage people for multi-fold productivity; people can produce multifold of their current inadequate output (such as 10\$/day value in countries where people are making less than 2\$/day) to be out of poverty. 10% annual GDP growth in developing countries is not enough.
2	Disrupt Hunger – avoid suffering, stunting and malnutrition Engage people in efficient food production methods from their surroundings; There is plenty to produce & manage
3	Disrupt unhealthy unsafe life: stop avoidable death and suffering Clean water, clean space and better sanitation will stop high mortality rates, particularly in children and women.
4	Disrupt unjust inequality – gender, racial and economic inequality cause suffering. Fair participation in everything – with increased awareness, improved productivity for all people, achieve gender and racial equality and for narrows economic gap
5	Disrupt bad actions on environment- Stop deforestation and degradation of ecosystem due to poor production methods. With renewable energy use, conservation programs and efficient production & consumption methods ecosystem can be restored.
6	Disrupt isolation and scattered living – lack of information, non-exposure to better way of living and lack of knowhow are obstacles to better life. Build planned cities to cheaply share water & energy, for economic exchange, work opportunities better living; Let's make all people know and work on their goals
7	Disrupt subsistence agriculture People work hard & starve under subsistence agriculture. Engage people in more activities: industry, manufacturing, services and efficient agriculture for trade and exchange; improved production and consumption
8	Disrupt slum living – Everyone can earn a home and good life if enabled Prepare better destination for people running away from unproductive subsistence agriculture and low-productivity; Fast-tracked training for transitioning into good jobs homes
9	Disrupt ineffective education system – stop producing schooled unemployable graduates Raise awareness for people to dream, aspire, wish and plan to reach goals; focus on practical skills to engage with the community and serve needs; stop language barriers in education – teach to benefit society
10	Disrupt dependence on donation/aid – we invest on our children to be independent, let's apply to others Invest in people to be productive multi-fold to solve all problems and pay back initial investments with returns; they can stop ecosystem degradation, stop migration and contribute in nurturing global peace.
11	Disrupt inefficiency – creating less than 2\$/day value is unacceptable; threatening peace Expose society to better ways of doing things, use of tools and technology; Share lessons and motivate people to innovate and create
12	Disrupt lopsided partnerships – stop unsafe, short-sighted extraction; Engage local people in better use of the resources in their surroundings; share technology, experience and initial capital investment and freely and safely participate in enormous multiple benefits and ecosystem protection.
